

1943 Ruffled Blouse Pattern Drafting Guide

<p>A,B - Shoulder length plus 3"</p> <p>A',B' - Shoulder plus 4" - adjust if needed for enough fabric to go over bust for gathers. End length should match the back.</p> <p>B',C – Shoulder to desired depth of neckline</p> <p>C, D – Measure over bust to half way down side seam (armhole to waist), add 3"-4" for gathers</p> <p>A',D – Draw curved line from A, then stop 2"-3" above D</p> <p>C', F – Deepest part of neckline to half way down side seam</p> <p>F,G – Measure to desired end length</p>	<p>F, I – Measure front center of Front Bodice (Under Bust or rib cage) to side. Make a mark.</p> <p>C, H - Depth of neckline to desired end Length</p> <p>B, J – 1/4 of totally neck circumference, dip down 2"-3" and curve.</p> <p>J, K – Length from base of neck to desired end length</p> <p>K, M – Middle of back waist to side</p> <p>O, P – Measure middle of upper back to start of arm, add 2"-3". Make mark, Curve in with A, L</p> <p>A, L – Draw curved line to 1"-2" under arm. Match with front.</p> <p>L, M – Measure to desired end length.</p>
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
