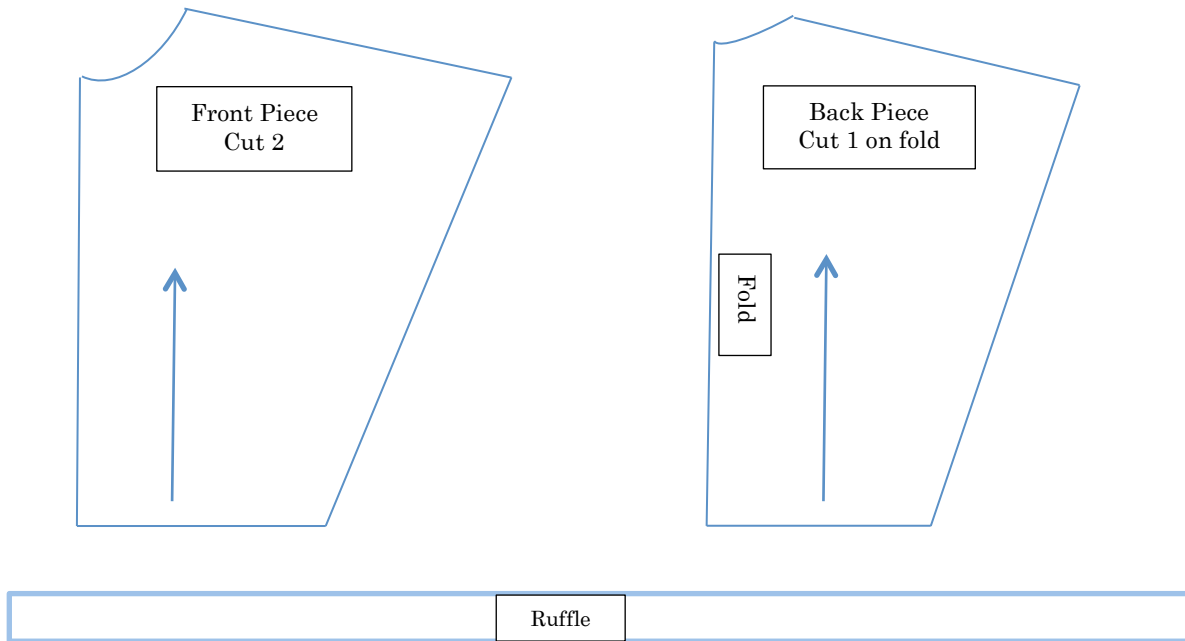


Regency Chemisette Pattern by Aimee Cook



How to Use this Pattern:

1. Measure from the base of your neckline to the end of your shoulder. Add 1". This is your shoulder measurement for both the front and back pieces.
2. Measure from the base of your throat to 1" under your bust line. Add 2 ". This is the measurement for the center front and center back of your chemisette pieces.
3. Create a curved line for the front and back neckline using the pattern shapes above as a guideline. Don't worry if there is too much space around the neckline. We will use darts to tighten this area up.
4. Cut out two front pieces and one back piece (on the fold) of the chemisette. Cut out a 90" long strip by 3-4" wide strip (or however wide you want the ruffle.) We will be creating a chemisette with one neck ruffle, but you may add as many ruffles as you would like.

Materials Needed:

- 1-1 ¼ yard of a white cotton, muslin, handkerchief linen, or regular linen.
- White double fold bias tape (as much to comfortably go around your neck plus 2-3"
- Thread
- 3-4 yards of white cording or white ribbon
